Notes for Contributors to the Sub-forum

The third "World Forum on China Studies" will be held in September, 2008 in Shanghai, which is a high-level and open academic platform sponsored by Shanghai Academy of Social Sciences.

the Proceedings of it containing all the texts of speech and papers presented before the audience of it and the most important ones of the other articles contributed to us. In addition, some excellent articles will be published in *The Journal of Urban Technology*. So the articles concerning any of the above-mentioned topics are warmly welcomed.

If the contributor/author keeps the following points in mind, his/her article will be preferred by the Editors: When the author discusses about "The Policy Package for Alternative Energy Exploration and Utilization", he/she is suggested to take Shanghai as the main example to conduct case study.

The author is suggested to contribute both the Chinese and English version of the article at the same time.

The author should submit the article through e-mail and send a hard copy to us. If the author contributes both the Chinese and English version of the article, he/she should send a hard copy of each version to us respectively. The Chinese article should contain 8, 000~12, 000 Chinese characters and the English one should contain 5, 000~8, 000 words, adopting American spelling. Articles illustrated with charts, graphs and graphics are welcomed and encouraged.

Before you send the paper, please submit the electronic version abstracts of the article, respectively in Chinese and English by the date of May the 30th, which contain 300-500 characters or words.

How to Prepare a Bibliography

To accommodate our goal of including citation apparatus, but making it unobstructive to non-specialists, authors are requested to minimize using explanatory footnotes and to use the following guidelines for citations:

- 1. Put all references on a separate page. If you submit an English article, please arrange the references alphabetically according to the last name of the author, do not invert the names of the authors, and put the last name at the end of the author's name. As to the English references, please refer to *the Journal of Urban Technology*.
- 2. Number all the references consecutively, and the number should be put in a square bracket (for example, "[1]").
- 3. When citing a reference in the text, simply put the number of the reference in a square bracket in the appropriate place in the text. When quoting directly, put the abbreviation p. and the page number of the quotation in a parenthesis just following the square bracket (for example, "[1] (p. 33)").
